



Walking Directions Het Booze Wijf - De Noorman & Entrypoint Seal Tour
2 km (1.25 miles) / 30 minutes

From Het Booze Wijf via the Floating footbridge towards the harbor

You'll start at the Museumharbor, next to the terrace of Het Booze Wijf, and walk along the harbor quay.

At the end of the harbor, you should see the floating footbridge crossing the pond. Cross the street and walk over the wooden footbridge*.

After crossing the pond you keep following the wooden path. You'll cross a bikepath and go straight**. Directly after turn right following the path. You are now crossing a small field (The Orchidfield) and end at a concrete bikepath.

Turn left and follow the bikepath. It's running slightly upwards. You'll find a crossing of the N361. You have arrived at 'Point A'.

After crossing the N361 you use the stairs to cross the dyke.

On the other side of the dyke, cross the street. You'll continue walking straight ahead until you hit water. You are now in the middle of the harbor.***

You make a right turn and keep on walking till you reach 'Point B'.

Make a left turn and keep walking alongside the water till you can make another left turn. You have arrived at the pier.

Walk toward the end of the pier and you will arrive at De Noorman. On the left you'll find the jetty used for entering the Seal Tour.

Did you know?

*The floating wooden footbridge was constructed in 2015.

**The Wooden square you'll see is called the 'Orchidwindow'. It will give you a neat view over the Orchid field.

*** The Harbor of Lauwersoog came into existence as a result of closing off the Lauwersmeer lake in 1969. First as a construction place, but soon after also used by fisherman. It grew into a true fisherman harbor. De Noorman gets its fresh fish straight from the harbor.
